

# **BYBSA General Rules**

### T-Ball

This is an instructional division, with the objective of giving players experience at playing multiple positions while building basic fundamentals to

#### **General Rules**

- 1. Commissioner will assemble teams
- 2. There will be <u>no forfeits</u>. There is NOT a minimum player rule. A team may borrow from the opposing team in order to assemble a complete team.
- 3. All Teams will qualify for the playoffs at the end of the season. We will conduct a blind draw for seedings. More details will be provided.
- 4. Each game will be 4 innings and last no longer than 1 hour.
- 5. Bases will be set at 50'.
- 6. No Bat Restrictions for this league.
- 7. All games shall start at the designated time. If an umpire is not available, one coach from each team shall umpire, alternating behind the plate and on the bases.
- 8. Players, managers and coaches only shall occupy the bench or dugout during the game.
- 9. Each team shall supply 1 new game ball each game. Other gently used baseballs can be used (old game balls) to help speed the game along.
- 10. It is mandatory for players to wear all safety equipment supplied by BYBSA

## **Defensive Rules**

- 1. For teams in the field, coaches may position themselves in foul territory and in the outfield to help instruct defensive players.
- 2. No more than 6 infielders are allowed (1B, 2B, SS, 3B, P, Short Fielder)
  - a. No defensive shifts (players must play natural positions)
- 3. The rest of the players can play outfield position (Both feet must be positioned in outfield grass)
- 4. Nobody should be on the bench.
- 5. All players must play an infield and outfield position at least 1 inning.
- 6. An infield player may not play the same position more than twice in a game.

## Offensive Rules

- 1. Every player on the offensive team will bat once each inning.
- 2. No score will be kept

- 3. No outs will be recorded. However, if a runner or batter is out they will simply go back to the bench.
- 4. <u>Hitter may only advance 1 base IF the ball is hit into the outfield.</u> No advancements on overthrows or baseballs hit in the infield.
- 5. Base runners are not permitted to leave until the ball has been hit.
- 6. No bunts, leadoffs, no steals, no tag ups
- 7. No infield fly rule
- 8. No Strikeouts/Walks

### Coach Pitch/Hitting off of a Tee

- 1. We will leave it up to coach discretion on whether to use the tee for their players or to pitch overhand.
- 2. If coach decides to pitch to players:
  - a. It is recommended that you throw from a kneeling position.
  - b. Batter gets 5 pitches to put the ball into play. After 5 pitches, a tee MUST be used.
  - c. It is recommended that the coach brings out a bucket of baseballs to use to speed up time.
  - d. A coach may stand behind the plate to catch/collect the thrown baseball. This coach can also retrieve the tee in case it is needed.

#### **Evaluation**

1. Each coach will be required to fill out a player evaluation at the end of the year. This evaluation will be essential in helping form teams in the future.
